

Updated Covid-19 Guidelines/Procedures for print studio use (3/23)

Summary: We want to keep our studio community safe and healthy while working in this shared space.

This policy is based on recommendations from [Washington State Department of Health](#) and [Jefferson](#) County health. In the event Washington State or Jefferson County ever impose different public health requirements, those requirements will supersede this policy.

COVID rules remain, but still evolving. That said, our policy boils down to common sense:

- Stay home if you're sick or could get someone sick.
- While you're here, take reasonable steps to keep people safe.
- Physical distancing is still encouraged. 6 feet apart
- Masks are currently optional with these exceptions. Please respect the wishes of those around you.
 1. Masks are required if recommended by the [Washington State Department of Health](#). For example, if you were potentially exposed to the virus or are recovering from an infection you should wear a mask while in the studio.
 2. In addition, masks are required if those signed up for studio use, at their discretion, request participants to do so.
 3. In larger gatherings and meetings depending on the current health conditions, the leader may request masks and pretesting.
- There is now a commercial-grade air filtration device in the studio. Keep it on when studio is in use.
- Do not come to studio if you should be isolating or quarantining. See the Washington Department of Health [Decision Trees](#) for details. In short: You should isolate yourself if you test positive for COVID, or if you have one or more COVID symptoms and no alternative diagnosis. See [Tree 1](#) for more details on isolation. You may have to quarantine if you had [close contact](#) with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID. Close contacts should check the current rules of quarantine via the Decision trees.

Corvidae Board asks all members and artists-in-residence to continue to:

- Use the special "log in" book, record your name, time in and out, purpose of studio use and check mark that you have cleaned and, if necessary, disinfected all used surfaces and items when you complete your session.
- If you use towels or rags for any purpose, take them home, wash them and return to Corvidae. A better option is to bring your own towels/rags and take them home with you.
- Bring your own water bottles, cups, etc. for personal use and take away when you leave.
- Bring your own personal mask to use if needed.
- Before you leave, clean all surfaces you touched including door handles, light and heat switches, faucets, table surfaces used, press controls and press beds, bathroom sink and toilet if used.
- Corvidae will do its best to continue to supply disinfectant, gloves, paper towels and general clean up supplies, but it is suggested that you come prepared with what you may need.
